

Immunization Requirements

The Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has the following immunization requirements for travel to Ghana:

- All travelers must be up to date with their routine vaccinations, including measles-mumps-rubella (MMR), diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis, varicella (chickenpox), polio, and your yearly flu shot.
- All travelers are required to provide proof of yellow fever vaccination (Yellow Card) to enter Ghana.
- Travelers are encouraged to get a prescription for Malaria medicine. Although Malaria medicine is not required to enter Ghana, it is highly recommended since Malar is found in 100% of the country.
- Other vaccines to consider include hepatitis A & B, typhoid, meningococcal, and rabies.
